I hope everyone has a wonderful summer. Hope to see all the children on September 9.

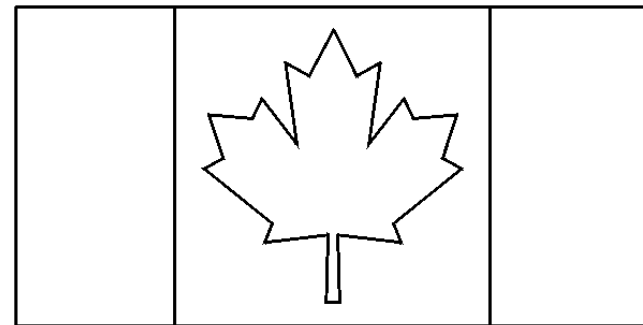
