*Sore throat, trouble  
swallowing*

*Runny nose*

*Loss of taste for smell*

*Not feeling well*

*Nausea, vomiting,  
diarrhea*

*Have you been in close contact with someone who is sick or has confirmed COVID-19 in the past 14 days?*

*Have you returned from travel outside Canada in the past 14 days?*

**If you answered YES to any of these questions, stay home & self-isolate right away. Call Telehealth or your health care provider, to find out if you need a test.**

## Procedures to Follow During Communion

- It is your choice whether or not to receive communion.
- Please follow the usher's guidance as to when to go up for communion. We will start at the front.
- Use hand sanitizer provided.
- Stop at first floor marker in front of priest (mask on).
- Step forward to the second floor marker to receive bread (mask on).
- Follow arrows to floor marker (mask on) with bread in hand.
- Remove mask, consume bread, replace mask.
- Use hand sanitizer provided.
- Return to your seat via your aisle.
