# SPECIAL VESTRY MEETING - JULY 28<sup>TH</sup> 2024

The Special Vestry Meeting will be held on Sunday, July 28th.

We received communication from the Diocesan's Director of Finance's office, the Finance Committee has been looking at ways to minimize the burden on parishes with external debt. "The Finance Committee's recommendation is to internalize the external debts of parishes and roll all loans into a single loan for each parish. The parishes will repay the Diocese at 4% principal plus interest on the first \$500,000 and 2% interest on the balance outstanding amount. The payment terms will be renegotiated after 10 years."

All existing loans and the assessment account debt will be rolled into this loan. Given that two weeks advance notice is required for a Special Vestry meeting, we are advising the congregation by including this notice in "This Week's News" for July 12 and July 19 and announcing at the services on July 14<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>.

In addition to the foregoing, please note the following:

- 1. St George on Yonge can prepay and terminate the loan at any time without any penalties.
- 2. The arrangement can be terminated with another vestry approval plus the approval of the Diocese if the loan amount is greater than \$75,000 as per Canon 6.
- 3. In the event interest rates decrease, the loan will be re-negotiated.
- 4. Under the arrangement outlined above, the parish will save significant amount of money which can be used for its ministry and other operational needs.
