VESTRY MEETING

The Vestry meeting for St. George on Yonge will be held after the service on Sunday, February 11th. It is taking place in person as well as on Zoom. The Vestry list is posted on the bulletin board in the Narthex. Please ensure that your name is on it if you are eligible. If you feel you should be on the list and are not, please contact the office administrator or speak to a Warden.

To be eligible to be part of the Vestry you must be baptized and declare:

"I solemnly declare that I have been a member of the Anglican Church of Canada and of this congregation for at least three (3) months, that I have attended regularly scheduled services of worship with this congregation at least three(3) times in the past year, that I am of the full age of sixteen (16) years and that I have not voted as a member of any other vestry during the previous three (3) months, nor do I intend to vote in any other vestry during the ensuing year."

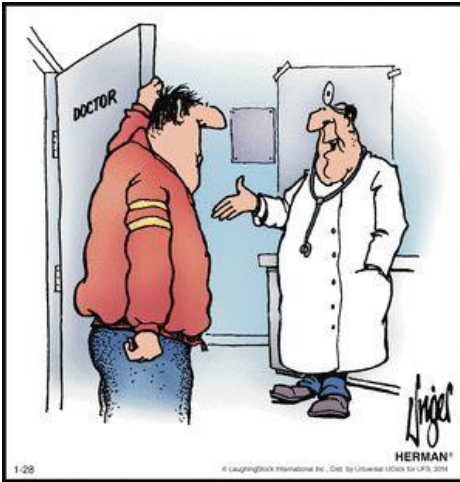
