According to your will give us wisdom as we continue our search.

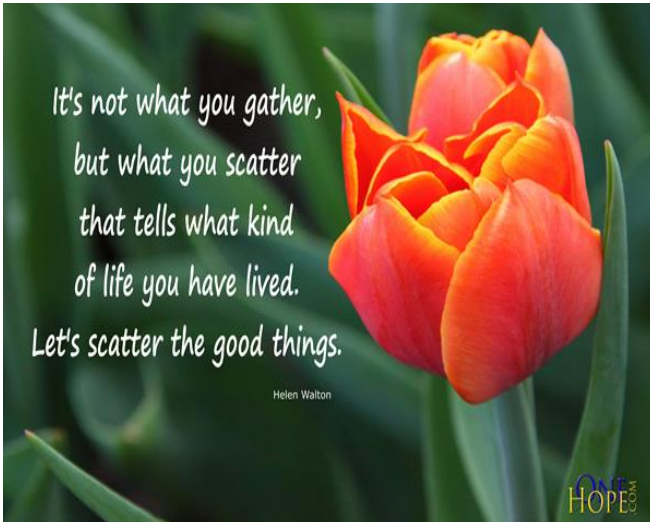
Be present in all our conversations.
